



**If you have an Appointment with the Social Worker for one of the reasons listed below, please bring the necessary documents and / or people to your upcoming appointment.**

**Income Support:**

- identification for you and your spouse or partner and any dependents
- 2 bank statements for 60 days prior to the date of application
- direct deposit information (direct deposit form from bank or a personal cheque with VOID written across it)
- medical letter – if you cannot work for medical reasons
- Information on Assets, Banking, RRSP's etc.
- If you're working, how much you are earning monthly
- Your partner will need to be present to sign
- SIN Number

**Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH):**

- identification for you and your spouse or partner and any dependents
- SIN Number
- Power of Attorney Documentation & Information (if you have one)
- Employment History
- Education and Training history
- Income information
- Information on Assets, Banking, RRSP's etc.
- Your partner will need to be present to sign

**Canada Pension Plan Disability (CPPD):**

- SIN Number
- Information for dependents including their SIN numbers if they have
- Information on your medical condition
- Information for your Doctor or Nurse Practitioner
- Direct Deposit Information

**Housing Application(s) (specifically Leduc Regional Housing):**

- identification for you and your spouse or partner and any dependents
- Copy of current lease (if applying for Rent Assistance Benefit)
- If household members are between 22-24 and are attending school, a copy of their student enrollment
- Notice of Assessment for previous year and for every household member over 22 years of age
- Financial Documentation (AISH, Alberta Works/Income Support statement, if applicable)
- Housing Information (current rental amount, landlord information, etc.)
- Information on Assets, Banking, RRSP's etc.
- All members over 18 need to be present to sign the application
